## Day 1 - Monday, June 17 - Home to Courtyard Marriott, South Portland, ME

- Your exciting group getaway departs this morning from your scheduled pick-up location.
- Please arrive at your pick-up location 15 minutes before departure, so we can have your luggage stored and allow time for you to get comfortably situated in your seat.
- Enjoy morning snack/coffee breaks, as well as an hour lunch stop during today's drive. Prices for these meals are not included in your tour package.



- We are pre-registered with Customs officials so expect minimal delays at all border crossings. Please read the \*Customs & Immigration section (last page of itinerary) regarding official documentation required for entry into the United States, as well as Collins Tours policies surrounding any decisions to deny you entry into the country.
- We expect an evening arrival at the Courtyard Marriott in South Portland, ME. For those interested we will drop you off at the mall to allow you time for shopping (at own expense). Later, we will pick you up and shuttle you to our hotel where your luggage will be waiting in your room for you.
- Your tour manager will check the group in, distribute your room keys, and have bags (one per person included) sent to your room.
- Dinner this evening is at your own expense.

## Day 2 - Tuesday, June 18 - All New Hampton Inn & Suites, West Yarmouth, MA (B. Welcome Dinner)

- Enjoy your complimentary full hot breakfast this morning before our check-out.
- We will stop for a mid-morning break before arriving at Quincy Market & Faneuil Hall Marketplace, located in downtown historical Boston.
- Enjoy some time exploring over 100 fine shops, specialty pushcarts and delightful restaurants at Faneuil Hall Marketplace and Quincy Market. Lunch is **on your own** today with a multitude of fresh made-to-order dining options in Quincy Market.
- Once we have finished shopping, we make our way down to West Yarmouth, Mass. Expect an afternoon arrival at the all-new Hampton Inn & Suites hotel - our home for the next three nights. West Yarmouth is located 3 miles East of Hyannis, the largest and liveliest of the seven villages in the town of Barnstable, MA. It is the commercial and transportation hub of Cape Cod and what many refer to as the "Capital of the Cape". It boasts miles of pristine beaches, breathtaking scenery, museums, and where former president John F Kennedy and his family had their summer home. Enjoy easy access to many local gems from our hotel



- including salt marshes, kettle ponds, bike trails, whale watching, dune tours, and golf courses.
- Once again, relax and enjoy your Collins Tours signature hotel check-in service as your tour manager distributes your room keys and has your luggage delivered to your rooms.
- Tonight, we gather for our Group Welcome Dinner, complete with a glass of beer or wine. (included)
- Following dinner, the remainder of the evening is at your leisure.

## Day 3 - Wednesday, June 19 - Martha's Vineyard - Hyannis (B)

- Enjoy a delightful hot buffet breakfast (included) before boarding the coach for our start to a full day of sightseeing on the island of Martha's Vineyard. Our first stop is Oak Bluffs where we will board our ferry to Martha's Vineyard and meet our Step-On Guide for the day (return ticket included). This scenic ferry crossing puts us in Oak Bluffs in approximately 45 minutes after reaching the mainland
- Stops for treasure hunting, shopping as well as lunch (on own) are planned in the wonderful town and tourist destination, Edgartown.
- Other stops today include the cliffs at Gay Head (Aguinnah), a chance to see Chappaquiddick Island, Wood's Hole the Martha's Vineyard Campground Association, and West Tisbury. Keep your eyes peeled as you may see David Letterman, Carly Simon, Jake Gyllenhaal, Meg Ryan, Bill Murray, Michael J Fox, Spike Lee and Kelly Ripa to name a few.



- We board the ferry again as we head back to our hotel for the evening.
- The remainder of the evening and dinner will be on your own and at your expense.

## Day 4 - Thursday, June 20 - Hyannis - Provincetown (B, Group Lobster Dinner- Seafood substitutes available)

- Start your day with another beautiful buffet breakfast **(included)** at the hotel.
- We begin our guided tour with the "Highlights of Hyannis," featuring historic Main Street, Hyannis Port, the Kennedy Memorial & museum, and a drive by look at St. Francis Xavier church. (**Tour price included** gratuities are additional and at your discretion).
- Next, on to the Lower Cape, featuring historical lighthouses, quaint towns, and world-famous beaches of the Cape Cod National Seashore.
- Enjoy shopping and a delightful lunch **(on your own)** during our afternoon stop in Provincetown. Many stores/souvenir shops are within walking distance!



- This evening, the coach will drive the group from our hotel to a fabulous local restaurant, where we will enjoy a tasty **lobster dinner (price included)!** (Chicken option also available. Your tour manager will take your order.)
- After our dinner, the coach will shuttle us back to the hotel, leaving you time to relax and enjoy the rest of the evening on your own.

## Day 5 - Friday, June 21 - Hyannis - Maine Evergreen Hotel, Augusta ME (B, Farewell Dinner)

- Your buffet breakfast is served inside the hotel restaurant before another exciting morning of exploring.
- Be sure to cover any personal incidentals (i.e., movie rental, phone charges) before checking out of the hotel this morning.
- Our first stop today is a visit to the Sandwich Glass Museum where we are treated to an educational glass blowing demonstration and fil on the history of glassmaking (**included**).
- Next up is a stop at Plymouth Rock. This waterfront monument showcases the storied rock where the Mayflower Pilgrims first landed in 1620.
- Following Plymouth Rock, we head to the historical and newly restored Mayflower II replica of the original ship that brought the Pilgrims to America 400 year. **(included)**!
- Lunch will be on your own and at your own expense.
- After lunch, meet your coach and bid farewell to beautiful Cape Cod! A short snack break and rest stop are built into this afternoon's drive.
- This evening as we arrive in Augusta, we gather for our "Farewell Dinner" complete with a glass of complimentary wine or beer. Share stories of time together and start planning our next getaway! (Meal included).
- We'll arrive this evening at the Maine Evergreen Hotel, our hotel for the evening. Relax during our group check in service as your tour manager distributes room keys and has your luggage delivered to each room.
- Following dinner, the rest of the evening is on your own. **(your expense)**

## Day 6 - Saturday, June 22 - Home (B)

- Enjoy your complimentary full hot breakfast before checking out of your room (included).
- We will have rest stops at locations and a lunch stop location convenient to our route.



- We make our way this morning to the Duty-Free Store and the Canadian Border for our appointment at the Duty-Free Store. Your duty-free allowance is \$800 per person.
- Your tour manager will represent the group at Canadian Customs and Immigration.
- All guests can expect to **return to their original pick-up points**. Arrival times will be sent to you at least two weeks before the tour departs. **NOTE**: All arrival and departure times are estimates and may change.
