


**Tentative Itinerary**

#### Monday, February 3<sup>rd</sup> – Day 1 – Depart Canada – Flight to Singapore

• With your valid passport in hand, depart the Maritimes on your scheduled flight, en route to Toronto, where you will meet your tour manager. The group will clear Customs in Singapore once you have landed, NOT in Toronto. (If Collins Tours Inclusive Airfare is purchased; luggage fees for your first checked bag, taxes, airline surcharges and your destination transfers to and from Airports and hotels are included).

# Tuesday, February 4<sup>th</sup> – Day 2 – Continued Journey by aircraft.

• Thanks to crossing the International Date Line your arrival in Singapore will take place on February 5<sup>th</sup>. Do not worry, you are not "losing" a day. You will cross the International Date Line again at the end of your tour in the opposite direction regaining that time back when you return to Canada.

### Wednesday, February 5<sup>th</sup> – Day 3 – Arrival in Singapore Marriott Tang Plaza

- Arrival in Singapore Feb 5th Once we have collected our bags in Singapore, meet your tour manager
- and board our private coach transfer to the beautiful 4.5-star Marriott Tang Plaza hotel located in the city centre. Your checkin will take place in the evening of the 5<sup>th</sup> of February due to the crossing of the International Date Line.
- Dinner will be served on board the flight and the rest of the evening is free.
- Upon arriving at our hotel, the tour manager will check the group into the hotel and distribute your room key. They will also have your bag sent to your room (luggage handling fee included 1 bag per person), a signature Collins Tours service that you can expect at each hotel and cruise ship check-in during your vacation.

# Tuesday, February 11<sup>th</sup> - Day 8 - Phu My (Ho Chi Minh City), Vietnam (B, L, D) OPTIONAL PRIVATE GROUP SHORE EXCURSION. PRICE TBD. - Included for reservations made by May31st, 2023 (Value CDN\$120 per person tax included)

- Enjoy breakfast and lunch onboard the ship before landfall.
- This afternoon the Sky enters the mouth of Vietnam's Soai Rap River to reach the port of Phu My at 2:00pm for an overnight stop giving you access to nearby Ho Chi Minh City, also known as Saigon, the largest city in Viet Nam with over eight million inhabitants. Enjoy this unforgettable experience and the ever-ready smiles of the locals. See the rickshaw drivers and motorbike riders skillfully negotiate the road side by side, while street vendors peddle an assortment of seasonal fruits.
- **OPTIONAL:** Today you can opt to take part in another optional private group shore excursion with your Tour Manager and fellow Collins Tours travellers. The city of Ho Chi Minh is filled with bustling markets. See the 19th-century French-built Notre Dame cathedral and Independence Palace, a modern building that was home to the President of South Vietnam during the Vietnam War. This shore excursion is sure to give you an insight on the daily lives of the locals firsthand.
- Remember, your ship stays in port overnight tonight for another full day in Vietnam!



### Wednesday, February 12<sup>th</sup> - Day 9 - Phu My (Ho Chi Minh City), Vietnam (B, L, D)

- Wake up in the Phu My port, The ship sets sail at 7:00pm this evening giving you plenty of time to further explore the city of Ho Chi Minh, or the countryside of southern Vietnam. Today is yours to explore this welcoming country on own.
- Tonight, the ship sets sale for another day at sea in the South China Sea.

# Thursday, February 13<sup>th</sup> - Day 10 - Sea Day (B, L, Group D)

Ornate mosques glitter in the sun with their golden domes and minarets. Visit the Brunei Museum, a repository of Malay culture and Islamic art, or take a water taxi over to Kampong Ayer, "the Water Village." Experience a trip back in time with a visit inland to a Dayak village. Back in Muara, look for silver jewelry, brass, and bronze items, intricately made heirloom sarongs and antiques.

• This evening the ship sets sail towards Kota Kinabalu, Malaysia.





# Saturday, February 15<sup>th</sup> - Day 12 - Kota Kinabalu, Malaysia (B, L, Group D) Optional Excursion TBA.

- The ship is scheduled to dock in Kota Kinabalu, our second port of call on the island of Borneo, from 7:00am to 4:00pm.
- Kota Kinabalu is a bustling, ethnically diverse city offering sightseers a diversity of culture. A gold-domed mosque, unique high-rise architecture and the Heritage Village all combine to paint a picture of the city's past. Perhaps you would like to venture into the interior to astonishing Kinabalu Park, where exotic plants and rare orchids flourish, or spend time on the glorious beaches and enjoy the local fresh fish.
- Join your fellow travellers and Tour Manager for a Group Dinner inside TBA dining room onboard the ship.
- This evening the Norwegian Sky sets sail towards our first port of call in the Philippines' Puerto Princesa.

#### Sunday, February 16<sup>th</sup> - Day 13 - Puerto Princesa, Philippines (B, L, D) OPTIONAL PRIVATE GROUP SHORE EXCURSION. PRICE TBA.

- Enjoy another breakfast onboard the ship before exploring your day in Puerto Princesa, Philippines!
- We are docked here today from 9:30 am until 6:00 pm this evening.

Puerto Princesa is full of history, nature, good food, and relaxing beaches. **OPTIONAL:** If you're feeling adventurous join your Tour Manager and fellow travellers to visit the Subterranean River-a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Enter the underground river by paddleboat (don't worry, and experienced guide does the paddling for you!). This is the most popular activity in the area, a true up-close view of the natural jungle and riverways! Price TBA.

• Enjoy dinner on own this evening as our ship sets sail towards Boracay, Philippines.

# Monday, February 17<sup>th</sup> - Day 14 - Boracay, Philippines (B, L, D)

- We arrive in Boracay, Philippines, our second of four ports in this welcoming country, at 8:30am until 6:00pm
- White Beach is this small island's most famous feature, with sand so pale it almost looks like icing sugar. The water is usually clear, warm and inviting-perfect for a swim! Away from the shore, you can find restaurants



that satisfy any craving. Perhaps, you would like to take part in a local spa treatment "Hot Kawa" seated in warm, relaxing waters infused with fragrant flowers and leaves. A 'kawa' refers to the huge cauldron that was traditionally used in sugar-making, specifically to process molasses. But since technology and advanced methods came along, these giant pans were replaced by sugar mill factories. Local residents found a way to reuse the pans, turning them into big tubs for hot baths (referred to as kawa baths) - a perfect way to refresh oneself.

- Mt. Luho towers over the island. Ascending to the top offers you a breathtaking view of this island widely known as a destination popular with international visitors seeking its white beaches.
- This evening our ship sets sail towards Manila, Philippines.

#### Tuesday, February 18<sup>th</sup> - Day 15 - Manila, Philippines (B, L, D) OPTIONAL PRIVATE GROUP SHORE EXCURSION. PRICE TBA.

- Today we reach the bustling capital city of Manila, Philippines docked from 7:00am until 5:00pm.
- **OPTIONAL** Join your Tour Manager and fellow travellers on an optional private group shore excursion into the city. Visit Intramuros, "The Walled City," the oldest district in Manila. This is what remains of the fortified city, which was the seat of power during Spanish Colonial times (1521-1898). Visit the elegant Malacañang Palace, the National Museum of the Philippines and Rizal Park. Price TBD.
- This evening the ship sets sail for our fourth and final port of call in the Philippines, Salomague.



### Wednesday, February 19th - Day 16 - Salomague, Philippines (B, L, Group D)

- Our ship arrives in Salomague, Philippines at 8:30am until 4:30pm.
- Just a short ride away from both the beautiful beach town of Cabugao and the must-see architecture of Vigan City, this port has something for everyone. If you can't get enough of the ocean, spend a relaxing day in a cove on a white sand beach. If you're looking to explore the history and culture of the Philippines, Vigan has multiple UNESCO World Heritage Sites to explore. Stroll through streets of well-preserved Spanish Colonial buildings and see where the Spanish-style architecture fused with Asian-style architecture. As you take all that in, get a taste of what they're cooking at one of many food carts throughout the city.
- Join your Tour Manager and fellow travellers for a group dinner this evening at the TBD Dining Room onboard the ship.
- This evening the Norwegian Sky sets sail towards Kaohsiung, Taiwan.

# Thursday, February 20<sup>th</sup> - Day 17 - Kaohsiung, Taiwan (B, L, Group D)

- Welcome to Taiwan! We are in port from 9:00am to 3:30pm. This unique port of call (Kaohsiung) was colonized by the Dutch in the 17th century has left an ample architectural legacy, as did Taiwan's rule by Japan from 1895-1945. Grab a coffee at the former British Consulate, a landmark overlooking the bay. Art lovers can enjoy the outdoors and contemporary sculptures at the Kaohsiung Museum of Fine Arts' Sculpture Park, and for a spiritual experience, a visit to the Fo Guang Shan Buddha Memorial Centre, with the world's largest sitting Buddha, is highly recommended.
- This evening meet your Tour Manager and fellow travellers for a group dinner onboard the ship and get details regarding tomorrow.
- Tomorrow, we disembark the ship in Taipei, Taiwan.

# Friday, February 21<sup>st</sup> - Day 18 - W Taipei Hotel. Taipei, Taiwan (B, Disembark Norwegian Sky)

- Enjoy breakfast onboard the ship before meeting your group for disembarkation from the ship to our transportation taking us into the metropolis of Taipei. We are greeted by our friendly local guide showing us the bargain shopping districts for Taiwanese lacquerware, silk and fine art, plus traditional sites, and temples of this fascinating city.
- We arrive at our hotel this afternoon, the 5-star W (Westin Hotel) Taipei hotel that is centrally located in the city, your home for the next three nights. Your Tour Manager will check you in to the hotel and have your luggage (one bag per person) delivered to your room for you.
- Enjoy this evening on own.

### Saturday, February 22<sup>nd</sup> - Day 19 - Taipei, Taiwan (B, Farwell Group D) OPTIONAL PRIVATE GROUP EXCURSION. PRICE TBA.

- Enjoy a full breakfast this morning before a day on own to explore this fascinating city. **OPTIONAL**: Excursion to ascend to the 91<sup>st</sup> floor of the cities striking landmark, the Taipei 101 skyscraper for an unforgettable view of the city, then we ride the Maokong Gondolas to reach a mountaintop with its ornate traditional temple. Price TBA.
- This evening we meet for our Farewell Dinner including a glass of wine or beer.

### Friday, February 23<sup>rd</sup> - Day 20 - Taipei, Taiwan (B)

Today is your final full day in Asia. Enjoy breakfast at the hotel. Take advantage of your time spent for those final shopping bargains or relax before your journey home tomorrow.



### Saturday, February 24<sup>th</sup> - Day 21 - Flight to Canada (B, Dinner on Flight)

• Today we begin our journey homeward towards Canada. Please enjoy one last breakfast inside the hotel. Complimentary transfers to the airport **for those who purchased Collins Tours Inclusive Air Package** (additional cost is listed on website for air package pricing). Sit back and enjoy the signature Collins tours check in procedure with one bag per person allowed. Today you will fly from Taipei to Canada crossing the International Date Line, arriving in Canada the same day we left Taiwan.
