Day 1: Monday, Jan 27 - Flight to Honolulu, HI - Courtyard Marriott Waikiki

- For those who purchased Collins Tours Inclusive Air & Transfers Package, fly from your local airport, and meet your tour manager in Toronto where you will fly together with Air Canada to Honolulu, HI. Your first piece of checked luggage (1 per person) is included in your airfare price.
- Upon arrival, collect your luggage in the baggage claim area and meet your tour manager as we board the motorcoach for our private transfer to the Courtyard Marriott Waikiki, your home for the next three nights.
- After a day of travel, take this opportunity to get a good night sleep and be ready for a thrilling day of activities tomorrow!

Day 2: Tuesday, Jan 28 - Honolulu, HI (B, Welcome Dinner)

- Experience a half day guided tour of Honolulu area (included), featuring: Kapolei Lookout, Diamond Head Crater, Punch Bowl Cemetery and more!

Day 9: Tuesday, Feb 4 – Tauranga, NZ (B, L, Cocktail Reception, D) *Optional Excursion "Tauranga Highlights"

- Tauranga (8:45 am 8:10 pm). Tauranga is a Harbourside City in the Bay of Plenty on New Zealand's North Island settled by Maori in the 13th century and by Europeans in the early 19th Century.
- Join your Tour Manager for today's optional excursion (PRICE TBA)! Today's half-day tour begins with city highlights of Tauranga before heading to the outskirts to enjoy a gentle bush walk to beautiful McLaren Falls. We then have a guided look at kiwifruit growing to learn why the coastal Bay of Plenty is the perfect place to grow the sweet fruit! Nest up, a stop at the highest location in the city, "The Minden" to look over the surrounding area. One of the most scenic locations in Tauranga is the Minden Lookout, a scenic viewpoint overlooking the city and beyond. It is 286 metres high and offers a sweeping panorama of the city as a whole. From Tauranga to Mount Maunganui and as far as the eye can see. We conclude our day tour with a beautiful drive along Mt Maunganui beach before returning to our ship!
- Today, the ship sails for Napier at 8:10 pm
- Tonight, meet your group friends for a Collins Tours Welcome Aboard Cocktail Reception. Light apps, alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages are included.
- Dinner is on your own tonight.

Day 10: Wednesday Feb 5 - Napier, NZ (B, L, Group D) *Optional Excursion "Hawkes Bay Wine Country"


- Napier (1:00 pm 7:00 pm). Napier is our gateway to wine country!
- Napier calls itself the Art Deco capital of the world, but it's also a leading wine-travel destination. Levelled by an earthquake in 1931, Napier was rebuilt in Art Deco style. Along with Miami Beach, Napier is one of the best examples of this style, with many of its structures well preserved.
- Join us for an optional excursion into famous New Zealand wine country (Price TBA)! We will travel towards the coast along the Tuki Tuki River Valley, undoubtedly one of the most scenic pastoral and vineyard drives in New Zealand, often compared to Tuscany. We will stop at Te Mata Peak (elevation 399 metres) to enjoy a breathtaking 360-degree view of the Heretaunga Plains. Here, we gaze out on orchards and vineyards on the plains to forestry, sheep and cattle farming on the surrounding hills. The formations of these hills and lower plains were created by glacial activity during the last ice age and create an amazing sense of awe. The peak is on the AA list of 101 things Kiwis must see in New Zealand! Next stop is a local winery where we will enjoy a range of wonderful local wines with incredible views of the Eastern side of Te Mata peak. After our guided tasting in Hawkes Bay wine country, relax on our leisurely drive with stunning views while returning to the ship.
- The ship sets sail for Wellington at 7:00pm
- Tonight, join your fellow travellers for a group dinner in one of the ships main dinning rooms! Bon appetite!

Day 11: Thursday, Feb 6 - Marlborough (Picton), NZ (B, L, D)

- Marlborough (Picton) (11:15 am 8:00 pm).
- Enjoy this free day to explore Picton! Built around a sheltered harbour, Picton is lined with cafés and restaurants for you to choose from. Popular attractions in Picton include a maritime museum and an aquarium. Relax as you browse the local shops that offer a wide range of trinkets, including handmade jewelry, paintings from local artists and woodcarvings.
- Set sail for New Zealand's capital city at 8:00 pm.

Day 12: Friday, Feb 7 – Wellington, NZ (B, L, Group D) *Optional Excursion "Highlights of Wellington"

- Wellington (7:00 am 3:00 pm). Located on the southern tip of the country's North Island, Wellington is the country's capital, home to National Archives, National Library, New Zealand Symphony Orchestra, and the Royal New Zealand Ballet.
- Today, we meet our private guide for an optional 4-hour Wellington city highlights tour (PRICE TBA). We
 - enter the Botanical Gardens via our ride on the famous Funicular, make several photo stops, notably on Mt Vic and visit the beautiful historic church of Old St Paul's with the astonishing wooden Gothic interior. Finally, we follow the waterfront to visit Te Papa Tongarewa, the National Museum of New Zealand. The museum reflects the country's pride, history and culture showcasing more than 800,000 artworks, objects and specimens! Explore the many exhibits on your own before we make our way back to our cruise ship.

Day 13: Saturday, Feb 8 - Lyttleton, NZ (B, L, Group D)

- Lyttleton (8:00 am 6:00 pm).
- Enjoy this free day to explore Lyttleton! Just 20 minutes from the centre of Christchurch city, Lyttelton is a charming port town with a long history. Today it's a vibrant town, home to a small community of 3,000 residents, filled with bohemian artists, cafés, restaurants and unique shops to discover.
- Tonight, join your fellow travellers for a group dinner in one of the ships main dinning rooms! Bon appetite!
- Set sail for Dunedin at 6:00 pm.

Day 14: Sunday Feb 9 – Dunedin, NZ (B, L, D) *Optional Excursion "Experience Dunedin"

- Dunedin (8:00 am 6:00 pm). Dunedin became wealthy during the central Otago Gold Rush. Today it is a university town with a UNESCO City of Literature designation.
- Join us this morning on another half-day signature Collins Tours optional private shore excursion (PRICE TBA), starting with a 15-kilometre journey from port to town. Pass by Forsyth Barr stadium, home of the Otago Highlanders Rugby Team, before making our way around the inner-city harbour through to Otago Peninsula High Road. Arrive at Larnach Castle for a guided tour (entrance included). Next, on to the Historic Railway Station, the most photographed historic building in New Zealand. We will continue our tour including Toitu Museum, Octagon (city centre) and St. Paul's Cathedral. Heading to North of the City to view the steepest Street in the southern Hemisphere before eventually passing by Dunedin Botanic Gardens (the oldest botanic garden in NZ) and the famous Otago university campus before returning to the port and our ship.
- Sail toward the "Sounds" at 6:00pm.

Day 15: Monday, Feb 10 - Dusky, Doubtful & Milford Sounds, NZ (B, L, Group D)

- Cruising through Dusky Sound, Doubtful Sound & Milford Sound. Visitors to Fiordland are treated to amazing scenery and New Zealand wildlife. Depending on wind and weather conditions, cruise ships can visit three fiords that were incorrectly called sounds by the early explorers. The designation is incorrect, but the names stuck.
- Tonight, meet your group tour friends for another group Dinner –located in ships main dining room.

Walk on the valley floor boardwalk under a canopy of tall tree ferns! Next, we make our way to the small town of Leura for free time and lunch on own before eventually making our way back to the hotel for late evening return in time for our farewell dinner.
