Day 1: Friday, Feb 21 - Maritimes - Courtyard Marriott, Portland, ME

- Board our premium motorcoach at your scheduled departure location and time.
- Please arrive at least 15 minutes before departure so we can get you comfortably situated.
- All stops for passenger pick-ups will be brief (10-15 min.) and we ask that you remain on board unless otherwise instructed by your tour manager.

- The drive today will include a coffee break as well as an hour lunch stop at a location that is convenient to our route (See table above). Snacks and lunch are your expense.
- Our border crossings are pre-registered and you can expect minimal delays during our crossing.
- Please be sure to have your *VALID passport for entry into the U.S. Note: Please review the "important details" of this itinerary, as far as policies and your responsibilities relating to entry into the United States.
- We expect to arrive in Portland early this evening. For those interested in a little shopping, we will drop you off at the Maine Mall before we check in at the hotel. The coach will meet you again at a designated time and location your tour manager will advise you of for your short transfer to the hotel. Your bags will be waiting in your room and your tour manager will have your room key ready.
- The motorcoach, and any of you who prefer to relax at the hotel, will then continue on to South Portland's Courtyard by Marriott Hotel. Your tour manager will check you in, hand out your room key and have your bag sent to your room. Dinner is on your own this evening.

Day 2: Saturday, Feb 22 - Portland, ME - Marriott Marquis, NYC (B) *Broadway Show

- Enjoy your complimentary hot continental breakfast at the hotel this morning. Your tour manager will handle group check-out; however, please be sure to cover any personal charges you may have incurred during your stay. Next, we depart early for New York City to ensure we maximize our time in "The Big Apple".
- A coffee break and hour lunch stop at the Blue Colony Diner are scheduled (your expense).
- Arrive at the stunning Marriott Marquis Times Square Hotel, located **in the heart of Manhattan**, late afternoon. Our signature group check in service is offered again today and we will have you relaxing in your room in no time! Your tour manager will check everyone in at the hotel, hand out room keys and have bags

delivered to your room. Please note: baggage handling may take up to 1 hour, but you do **not** need to be in your hotel room when the bags are delivered.

- After some time to freshen up, board the coach for a night on Broadway (performance TBA). Meet your tour manager this evening for your transfer to your theatre. After the show has finished return transfers will be provided at no additional charge for those interested or enjoy a 10minute walk to your 4-star hotel!
- Dinner and remainder of the evening are at your leisure.



Day 3: Sunday, Feb 23 – Embarkation from New York City, NY aboard Norwegian Escape (L, D)

- Enjoy breakfast at a location of your choice **(your expense)** before checking out of the hotel. There are different diners within walking distance from our hotel serving breakfast.
- After breakfast, board the coach for our professionally guided morning tour of NYC's most notable attractions, including Grand Central Station, Rockefeller Plaza, and some more midtown Manhattan notables.



- Following our informative tour, we make our way to Manhattan's Pier 80 to board the Norwegian Escape, where you will enjoy lunch on board (**included**). Your tour manager will assist with your pier-side check in, conveniently completed in advance by your Collins Tours staff!
- Please note: Your luggage will be delivered to your stateroom as soon as possible. Not all cabins will be ready upon check-in, and checking into your cabin will not be guaranteed until after 3:00 pm.
- Be sure to head out on deck for the cast off and wave Bon Voyage as you sail down the Hudson River, passing Lady Liberty, gliding under the Verrazano–Narrows Bridge and cruising out into the Atlantic!

Day 4: Monday, Feb 24 - At Sea (B, L, Cocktail Reception, Group D)



Day 7: Thursday, Feb 27 - San Juan, Puerto Rico (B, L, D) *City Tour and Old San Juan - Collins Tours Optional Excursion

- Today we dock in San Juan, Puerto Rico from 12:00pm 8:00pm
- Meet your fellow group participants for an optional Collins Tours shore excursion. We will have an unforgettable best of San Juan excursion, not to be missed exploring this colonial gem of the Caribbean with its contrasts of old and new in Old San Juan, and adjacent neighborhoods. Visit the historical district of Old San Juan, see Fort San Cristobal before travelling to the "New City" which will take you to the Condado District filled with high-rise condos and luxury resorts. Stop at the Capitol Building for a photo opportunity. Return to Old San Juan where you will visit the famous Plaza Colón. (Price TBA).

Day 8: Friday, Feb 28 - Basseterre, Saint Kitts and Nevis (B, L, Group D) *Optional Excursion

- Today we are docked in Basseterre, Saint Kitts and Nevis from 11:00 am 7:00 pm.
- Although founded by the French in 1627, St. Kitts is a very British paradise where cricket and tea are the norm. The dramatic mixed island landscape is rimmed in gold-sand beaches and dotted with well-preserved plantations left over from when the island was covered with sugar cane.
- Join Collins Tours for a private shopping and sightseeing tour! Today's tour highlights include visiting important sites such as Independence Square (formally the location of the town's slave market) before we make a brief stop at the Old Sugar Factory Ruins, the first Rum Distillery in the Caribbean. From here we make our way to Romney Gardens, get your cameras ready for this lush tropical garden. We then make our way to the famous Caribelle Batik Studios and then onto the Botanical Garden of Eden in Paradise. Lounge underneath a large 400-year-old Saman Tree that overlooks the Caribbean Sea! This is also a chance to shop at the boutique and gift shops. The next stop is the Village of Middle Islands to view the oldest Anglican Church in the Southern Caribbean. (Price TBA)
- Tonight, we meet for another group dinner in the ship's dining room.
- Tonight, we sail for St. Lucia!

Day 9: Saturday, Mar 1 - Castries, St. Lucia (B, L, D) *Optional Excursion

- Today we are docked in Castries, St. Lucia from 11:00 am 8:00 pm.
- Castries is known as a mecca for outdoor enthusiasts with thriving coral reefs and rain forest preserves.
- Meet your fellow group participants for an optional Collins Tours shore excursion. Get your cameras ready as we visit the Caribbean's only drive in volcano with its bubbling Sulphur Springs! No visit to St. Lucia is

complete without viewing the seaside peaks, the majestic pitons. From there we will make our way to the islands only working plantation within a traditional village setting. (**Price TBA**).

• Tonight, we sail for Antigua!

Day 10 Sunday, Mar 2 - St. John's, Antigua (B, L, Group D)

- Today we are docked in St. John's, Antigua from 11:00 am 7:00 pm.
- Take in the splendor of the city's skyline, dominated by St. John's Cathedral's white baroque towers. Discover the grand St. John's while sampling local cuisine, experiencing the Botanical Garden, admiring Antigua's magnificent lighthouse, and exploring the historic Fort James.
- Tonight, we meet for another group dinner in the ship's dining room. Your tour manager will assist you in finding our group seating once again.
- Tonight, we sail for Philipsburg in St. Maarten!

Day 11: Monday, Mar 3 - Philipsburg, St. Maarten (B, L, D) *Optional Excursion

- Today we dock in tropical Philipsburg, St. Maarten from 8:00 am 5:00 pm.
- With an area of only 37 square miles, the island of St. Maarten is the smallest landmass in the world to be divided between two governments. The southern Dutch half offers casinos, duty-free shopping and island culture. The French half is all subdued sophistication.

- Tomorrow we arrive in beautiful Tortola, British Virgin Islands.

- Board the motor coach for our morning departure followed by a brief coffee break and 1-hour lunch stop (your expense) along our route. Please use the restroom prior to departing our stop as the restrooms at the Duty-Free Store are very limited.
- We then report to Canadian Customs at our scheduled time. Once again, your tour manager will represent the group at customs. NOTE: Duty free allowance for this trip is \$800 per person. Please see your Canadian Customs and Immigration forms (handed out by your tour manager on your return) for amounts of Alcohol and Tobacco allowances.
- Time to bid farewell. Everyone will be returned to their **original pick-up locations**.
