Day 1 - Sunday, June 2 - Overnight flight to Zurich, Switzerland

For those who purchased Collins Tours Inclusive Air, you will depart from your local airport and meet your Tour Manager and fellow travelers at Toronto airport for group flight to Zurich. All passengers are flying on Air Canada flights and traveling together from Toronto direct to Zurich, Switzerland. PLEASE NOTE: Each passenger has 1 piece of luggage included up to 50 lbs each bag, included in the Collins Tours Inclusive Airfare Package. Additional pieces of luggage may require fees paid directly to the airline. Fees will be charged on both the outbound and return flights if applicable. Be sure to have your valid passport for Customs & Immigration which you will clear in your final destination, Zurich, and not in Toronto.

Day 2 - Monday, June 3 - Zurich - Lucerne, Switzerland (Welcome Reception)

- Arrive in the Zurich in the morning, the largest airport in Switzerland. After clearing customs, we proceed to the baggage carousel to collect luggage and meet our private deluxe motorcoach for transfer to Lucerne. Please collect your own luggage from the baggage carousel. Once we meet our coach, your luggage (1 piece per person) is looked after and will be delivered to your hotel room upon check-in, later this afternoon.
- We expect to arrive late morning into Lucerne, where we meet our local tour guide! We will arrive in Lucerne and begin our tour with an exciting gondola ride to the top of Mount Pilatus. After our time at the summit, where you can have lunch on own at the cafeteria, we will descend via cogwheel!
- This afternoon, we check into the 4 Star Hotel Continental Park located in the heart of the city, where your luggage will be delivered to your room. Note: Check in is not guaranteed until 3:00 p.m. Early check in has been requested. You will be arriving late afternoon in order to provide adequate time for rooms to be ready. If rooms are not ready, you are walking distance to the Train station which has multiple shops and restaurants.
- Join us for a "Welcome Reception" with wine and appetizers at your hotel. Dinner this evening is on your own with plenty of options just steps away from our hotel.

Day 3 - Tuesday, June 4 - Lucerne, Switzerland (B, Welcome D)

- Wake up and enjoy a delicious Swiss breakfast buffet this morning (included).
- After breakfast, meet your Tour Manager and local guide for a 2.5-hour guided walking tour of Lucerne
 (included). After the tour, enjoy lunch on your own in one of the many cafes with free time in the
 afternoon. Transportation will be provided back to the hotel at a designated time to freshen up before our
 group dinner!

This evening, please meet your Tour Manager and join your fellow Collins Tours group passengers for a
"Welcome Group Dinner" at the fabulous Psistern Zunfthaus restaurant, just a short walk from our hotel.

Day 4 - Wednesday, June 5 - Lucerne - Stresa, Italy (B, Cocktail Reception)

After another delicious Swiss Buffet breakfast this morning, get ready for an exciting journey through the Alps. Travel by premium motor coach to Locarno which is a small, picturesque town on the border of Switzerland and Italy. Enjoy lunch (on own) and some time for shopping before leaving for our hotel. Our hotel, the Hotel Regina Palace in Stresa, is a beautiful 5-star hotel across the mountainous border from Switzerland to the Lake District of Italy. You have all been upgraded to the Lakeview rooms at this hotel, included in your tour package!



- We expect to arrive at the Hotel Regina Palace late this afternoon. Once again, your Tour Manager will handle check-in for your group and have your luggage delivered to your room all part of the Collins Tours experience! Please note passports are required to be photocopied upon check in. This is part of Italy's regulation process. - ➤ Baggage allowance details: For all Air Canada flights to and from Europe: You are allowed one personal and one carry on item at no charge (max dimension 23 cm x 40 cm x 55 cm). You are also allowed one free checked bag (max weight 23 kg; \$100 fee for overweight bag).
- Euro's can be used for any purchases made off the ship during this cruise tour.
- > Duty Free Rules allow you to claim \$800 per person.
- Airline fees for any checked baggage overages or additional bags (both outbound and inbound flights) are **NOT** included in your tour package and any additional costs are your responsibility paid directly to Air Canada.
- All liquids/gels you plan to bring on board an airplane must be 3oz or less and sealed in a Ziploc bag. Once at the security checkpoint, this bag must be removed from your carryon & placed in bin for TSA screening.
- > Prescription medication should be kept in original container or carried with you during travel.
- > Collins Tour is not responsible for lost or stolen baggage and/or personal items.
- > Covid-19 Protocol.
